## Club night returns

Wednesday 31 January 2007 in the Activity Hall of Hallett Cove South Primary School, Livonia Street, Hallett Cove. See you there at 7pm and don't forget to bring your gear and a water bottle!

## Club fees

The Committee decided in 2006 to raise the term fees by \$1 per week. Term 1 2007 is an 11 week term, so term fees will be:

1 <sup>st</sup> family member pays 100%.....	\$110
2 <sup>nd</sup> family member pays 50% .....	\$55
3 <sup>rd</sup> family member pays 50% .....	\$55
4 <sup>th</sup> and subsequent family members pay only .....	\$20

The annual club fee still remains at \$20 per active club member and \$5 per non-active club member (capped at \$60 per family). Payment of all fees is requested by week 3 of term.

## Polo shirts

For those who ordered the new club polo shirts, they are ready and I will bring them on the 31<sup>st</sup>. If you had your name embroidered, the cost is \$41. With no name, the cost is \$37.

## Fundraising

The last of the chocolate monies are now coming in, and when the final figure is tallied we hope to have raised just over \$1,000 from this activity (this paid for our 3 fencing bags on wheels). Advance notice: there is a federal election later this year, so we will be running sausage sizzles which we would like you all to help out with. The Committee also put in a grant application to the Office of Recreation and Sport in November 2006 and we will hear in March as to whether we have been successful or not.
